Resolutions

1 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves to establish an Outreach Task Team (OTT) to create a coordinated approach for promotion and education about ISO/TC 209 Standards under the leadership of Anne Marie Dixon.

2 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves that every Convenor will submit a whitepaper on their Standard along with the FDIS voting draft to foster promotion and education.

3 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves to issue a second DIS of ISO 14644-3.

4 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves that a NWIP should be developed for ISO 14644-4.

5 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves to provide a NWIP for ISO 14644-17 on particle deposition rate taking into consideration concerns about the title and confusion with ISO 14644-3 and 14699-9.

6 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves to begin a PWI under the leadership of Germany that focuses on assessment of suitability of consumables and does not replicate established test methods. The Secretariat should issue a call for experts. The work shall be harmonized with ISO 14644-5.

7 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves that all standards in the 14644 and 14698 families only use the term “cleanroom” when ISO 14644-1 is applied. When other cleanliness attributes are used without being associated with ISO 14644-1, the term “controlled zone” shall be used.

8 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves that ISO 14644-8, -9 and -10 shall be revised to include at least the removal of the term “classification” from the titles and “classification” and “class” from the bodies of the documents except for references to ISO 14644-1, and replacement with suitable terms.

9 Sydney/2017

ISO/TC 209 resolves to advance the Systematic Review of ISO 14644-5 to the next rotation of Systematic Reviews. The Secretariat will review the use of an amendment or other format to correct Annex D.2.3.
